Schools Identified for Improvement

In 2005-06, none of our schools were on School Improvement.

Professional Qualifications of Teachers

In 2005-06 we did not have any teachers with Emergency or Initial credentials. Three of our teachers were not Highly Qualified under No Child Left Behind.

- 1 Gypsum Creek Middle School teacher, or 5.88 percent of classes at that school. Gypsum Creek Middle School had 26 percent of students who qualified for free or reduced lunch.
- 1 Berry Creek Middle School teacher, or 5.88 percent of classes at that school. Berry Creek Middle School had 53 percent of students who qualified for free or reduced lunch.
- 1 Minturn Middle School teacher, or 7.14 percent of classes at that school. Minturn Middle School had 20 percent of students who qualified for free or reduced lunch.

Students Not Tested

1.5 percent of Eagle County's students did not take CSAP tests in 2005-06. Of these students:

- 11 percent were White
- 88 percent were Hispanic
- 1 percent was Black
- 41 percent were Female
- 59 percent were Male
- 81 percent were ELL
- 76 percent qualified for free or reduced lunch
- 13 percent were on IEPs
- 17 percent were Migrant
