

Type C Contracts

The Board of Education desires to be as cost effective as possible in providing student transportation to and from school. Because it is at times difficult to operate a bus in specific areas, the Board of Education is supportive of offering Type C contracts in accordance with Colorado State Law C.R.S. 22-32-114 to parents who live in areas inaccessible to buses or who live in areas that are sparsely populated and a long distance from a bus stop.

REGULATIONS:

1. The Business Office will be responsible for the administration of student transportation and Type C contracts.
2. No parent/guardian will receive compensation for a Type C contract unless a contract has been signed and is on file in the Business Office.
3. A valid drivers' license will be required before a parent/guardian is eligible for a Type C contract if that parent/guardian is transporting his/her own child(ren). The parent/guardian will provide his/her name, date of birth, and a valid drivers' license number to the Director of Transportation prior to the beginning of each school year. Parents/guardians will only be authorized by and receive reimbursement from the School District to transport their own student(s).
4. Type C contracts will be offered for transportation that is beyond walking distance (*as defined in Policy EEAA*) to and from the nearest bus stop.
5. Reimbursement for Type C contracts will be at the mileage rate set for School District employee expense reimbursements. Parents/guardians eligible for Type C reimbursements must submit an invoice to the Business Office at the end of each quarter.
6. Type C payments will only be paid to a parent/guardian for his/her own child(ren). Type C reimbursements will only be made for mileage to and from a bus stop for the regular school day in which the child(ren) actually ride the bus. (*i.e. mileage will not be paid to and from a stop for extracurricular activities, special school activities, summer school, etc.*).
