

Staff Participation in Community Activities

Members of the Eagle County School District staff shall be encouraged to take an active part in the affairs of the Eagle County School District. The school and the community should not be considered separate and apart, but as working as a unified whole in the educative progress. Through dynamic leadership, many avenues may be opened for building community support.

The Superintendent is urged to identify (him)herself personally with the many facets of community life, providing opportunities for all citizens--including nonparents--to experience relationships with the schools.

The principal, as the leader of his/her school, is encouraged to be an active and leading member of the school community.

The teacher, or the degree to which the teacher is known and accepted as a citizen of the community, has a direct relationship with the degree of understanding and goodwill flowing from the community to the schools.

The classified staff provides an integral communication link between the School District and the community. Classified employees are encouraged to take an active and leading role as members of the community.
