

Booster Organizations and Similar Groups

The Eagle County School District Board of Education recognizes that booster organizations and similar groups and individuals are a valuable means of stimulating parent/community participation in the schools.

Proposed plans, projects or movements of booster organizations and similar groups and individuals must be evaluated and promoted in light of their stated contribution to the programs of the schools. Careful consideration should be given to the total value of such contributions to all students. Care must be taken to avoid compromising or diluting the responsibilities and authority of the Board of Education.

All contributions shall be accepted by the Board of Education as Eagle County School District property if such contributions meet the following conditions:

- a. Tangible items with a value of \$100 or more that are intended to stay in the inventory of materials/equipment.
- b. Money in the amount of \$500 or more.

Donors of the above items may be formally recognized by the Board of Education. In addition, principals shall recognize contributions in lesser amounts than those specified above.

This policy does not apply to fund raising where funds are accounted for as part of the school's Activity Fund.
