# CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

- College Level Classes taught at Eagle Valley High School during the normal school day
- Classes taught by ECS teachers who meet the Higher Learning Commissions requirements; usually a Master degree in the discipline

# CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

- Eagle County Schools will pay for tuition and fees
- Tuition will need to be repaid for grades below a C-
- Most classes are guaranteed to transfer in the State of Colorado and many other colleges and universities accept Colorado Mountain College credit

## Transfer CMC Credits ► Reduce College Debt

Most of CMC's courses are included in Colorado's Guaranteed Transfer program. This means that they are guaranteed to transfer, by law. In addition, our students have transferred credits to private and out-of-state institutions, protecting those students from heavy debt loads as they start their careers.

- **What is a CNA?**

CNA stands for Certified Nurse Aide. Certified Nurse Aides are trained to provide basic care of patients such as obtaining vital signs and assisting with daily activities such as bathing, eating, showering, bathroom visits, and daily chores. They often report to doctors or nurses, and they are often compassionate people who enjoy helping others. CNAs work in long-term care facilities that help the elderly, disabled, or other patients in need. They also work in hospitals helping with patients. Some students who are interested in going into other medical fields will start with CNA in order to gain experience in health care fields. The nurse aide program can be a great gateway to health care fields such as Medical Assisting, Surgical Technology, Phlebotomy, Radiology Technology, Occupational Therapy, Nursing, and Medicine.

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# TIMELINE OF STEPS

- **January-May**-Students take Accuplacer
- **March-April**-Students begin requesting classes for next school year
- **May**-Students & parents attend orientation
- **JUNE**-CMC receives request numbers from high school
- **July**-Classes are built
- **August**-Students attended HS registration day, pick up their schedule and get registered for their dual/concurrent enrollment classes.

- Must be at college level reading. And math, if taking a math class.
- Complete CMC Concurrent Enrollment application.
- Purchase books if required.
- Responsible for registering or dropping classes.
- Understanding the course syllabus.
- Logging onto Basecamp & Canvas.

- No late work.
